PROCEDURE FOR PRIVATE ROAD NAMING (Continued) FNSBC 17.40

- 8) After acceptance, the Department will process the private road naming application within 30 days.
- 9) Written notification of the Department's decision will be issued to all adjoining property owners. Including any required addressing changes for the affected adjoining properties.
- 10) Any affected property owner may appeal in writing within two weeks of the decision.
- 11) After the appeal period passes a platting officer or designee will notify the applicant and specify the location of required street name signs and provide the successful applicant with specification for the street sign installation. Applicant will be required to provide and install standard street name sign(s) on standard post(s).
- 12) The applicant will document the installation of the street signs with digital photos of the signage showing the sign post and proper location and submit the images to Community Planning Department.
- 13) New road name will not become effective until photo verification is submitted to the Department that the sign(s) has (have) been installed.
- 14) Upon receipt of the photo documentation of the signs the following data will be updated:
 - a. The FNSB GIS centerlines & addresses. Address update letters will be sent to affected owners.
 - b. Assessor street address records (but not mailing addresses, the applicant shall contact the assessor to update mailing addresses)
